Attention Alabama Taxpayers

Since the inception of the Scholarship *for* Kids program, we have received **\$560,000 with **\$187,000** expected this year. Please help us continue the tradition at St. Ann School...**

Redirect your Alabama state income tax dollars to St. Ann School and other Catholic schools in the Diocese of Birmingham via *Scholarships for Kids SGO* (a 501(c)3 corporation) **AT NO COST TO YOU**. Receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for any tax dollars you redirect before December 31, 2017 or until the annual, statewide limit of \$30 million dollars is claimed for the 2017 tax year.

Corporate Contributors (S corporations, C corporations, and LLC Partnerships) may redirect up to 50% of their TOTAL Alabama tax liability and there is no maximum limit for the tax credit.

Individual Contributors may redirect up to 50% of their Alabama state tax liability up to the annual maximum tax credit of \$50,000. Tax credits will be awarded on a first come, first served basis, and may be carried forward for 3 years.
